



Municipality of Skagway Chauffeur Permit Application Instructions



- If you don't have an Alaska Driver License you must obtain one before You can be issued a Chauffeur Permit.
- Fill out the application completely and legibly and if applicable in ink.
- Attach a copy of your medical card or physicians report.
- Attach a copy of your current driver history (past 3 years). If you are unable to obtain a driver history at the time of application you may qualify for a one-time, 30 day, temporary permit.

Alaska driver histories are available for a fee of \$10.00.

Driver histories from states other than Alaska cannot be obtained at the police department.

Driver histories are obtained through the states in which you have held a driver license.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 19 years of age.
- Must have a minimum of 3 consecutive years driving experiences immediately preceding application.
- Must not have been convicted of reckless driving, driving under the influence, or leaving the scene of an accident for the last 3 years.
- Driver history must show that applicant has been a safe and careful driver for a minimum of 3 consecutive years immediately preceding application.
- Must have health certificate or written statement from a physician or physician's assistant certifying that the applicant has a good eyesight and hearing, has no disability or disease which would adversely affect his ability to operate a public vehicle and that the applicant is not afflicted with any communicable disease. The health certificate is adequate for 2 years following its issuance.

If the applicant is denied, the Chief of Police shall state in writing to the applicant, the reason for denial. Denials are subject to the appeal and judicial review provisions set forth in Skagway Municipal Code (SMC) 5.01.070 and 5.01.080.
